## **School Direction**

- The beginning of the year has gone very smoothly, classes started on day 1 and children seem happy and settled. We have an additional class this year, 12 classes to 13 classes with a total enrolment of 316 students.
- We are continuing to focus on our school being a collaborative school with acknowledgement and involvement from our parent/community body. This will become increasingly important as move into Local Schools Local Decisions (LSLD)

Most of the RAM funding has already been allocated to our Minilit and Multilit program. This program is topped up with school funds. In 2014 we spent

\$87,866.97 on our SLSOs, the majority being the Minilit and Multilit program as well as support in the Kindergarten rooms and some Numeracy classes.
